A New Jersey native and graduate of Montclair State University, John Laux was a highly competitive sportsman, supporter of Special Olympics New Jersey and career Young Insurance Professional. John's decade-long work in the insurance industry was tragically cut short after a brief and hard fought battle with cancer. He has been recognized posthumously by PIANJ for his impact on the industry and remains fondly remembered as one of the strongest supporters of NJYIP.
